The District Court of New South Wales is the largest jury trial court in Australia and has an appellate jurisdiction. It is the intermediate Court in the judicial hierarchy and its criminal jurisdiction deals with all criminal offences except murder, treason and piracy. In its civil jurisdiction the Court deals with motor accident cases, irrespective of the amount claimed, and other claims up to \$750,000.
