## District Court Criminal Practice Note 9

## **Standard Case Management Directions**

This Practice Note amends District Court Criminal Practice Note 9 issued on 1 September 2013. It is to take effect from 14 July 2017.

- 1. Unless the Court orders otherwise, notice of the prosecution case pursuant to s141 (I)(a) of the *Criminal Procedure Act* 1986 should be given to the accused person no later than **five weeks** prior to the date set for the trial.
- 2. Notice of the defence response to the prosecution's notice pursuant to s141(I)(b) of the *Criminal Procedure Act* should be given no later than **21 days** prior to the date set for trial.
- 3. Notice of the prosecution response to the defence response pursuant to s141 (I)(c) of the *Criminal Procedure* Act should be given prior to the date set for trial.
