District Court Criminal Practice Note 10

Work Health and Safety Act Prosecutions

The following arrangements are to apply from the date of commencement of the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*.

- A summons issued pursuant to the District Court Rules, Part 53 Rule 26, shall be returnable before the Sydney District Court on the first Friday 6 weeks following the date of issue.
- 2. The summons should be served within 7 days of the date of issue. A copy of this Practice Note is to be served with the summons.
- 3. The defendant or the defendant's legal representative is to file with the court and serve on the prosecutor a *Notice of Appearance* in the approved form within 7 days of service of the summons.
- 4. The prosecution is to serve the brief of evidence on the defendant's legal representative within 14 days of service of the *Notice of Appearance.*
