District Court Criminal Practice Note 9

**Standard Case Management Directions** 

This Practice Note replaces District Court Criminal Practice Note 9 issued on 18

December, 2009 and it is to take effect upon the commencement of sl41(I) of the

Criminal Procedure Act 1986 as amended.

1. Unless the Court orders otherwise, notice of the prosecution case pursuant to

sl41(I)(a) of the Criminal Procedure Act 1986 should be given to the accused

person no later than three weeks prior to the date set for the trial.

2. Notice of the defence response to the prosecution's notice pursuant to

sl41(I)(b) of the Criminal Procedure Act should be given no later than 10

days prior to the date set for trial.

3. Notice of the prosecution response to the defence response pursuant to

sl41(I)(c) of the Criminal Procedure Act should be given prior to the date set

for trial.
